Reflecting on the developments taking place at the school, notable among them is raising academic standards, infrastructure and environmental development, we would really need assistance in the following areas:

- a. Lighting system in the school needs more improvement as more solar panels and batteries are should be bought. The availability of these would increase the light in the school and classrooms for use by students and staff as we have now encouraged night studies for students under the supervision of staff.
